

CALL FOR SPECIAL ISSUE PROPOSALS

L'Homme. Revue française d'anthropologie publishes annually a Special double issue, selected by the editorial board among received proposals. Special issues explore a range of subjects in all the component fields of anthropology, without restriction of topic or geographical area. They combine ethnographic description with a comparative perspective, and engage in theoretical debates. A Special issue typically consists of an introduction of about 6,000 words written by the guest editors, followed by six to eight contributions of 12,000 words maximum. Essays should be original and not published elsewhere.

To publish a Special issue in *L'Homme* in 2024, proposals should be submitted to the editors at redaction.lhomme@ehess.fr by no later than 15 March 2023. Proposals should be 2,000-2,500 words in length and include a brief description of the overall theme, explaining its contribution to the existing literature and relevance to anthropology in current debates, as well as a short summary (200 words) and working title of each anticipated paper, mentioning the name(s), contact details and institution of all prospective authors. Once the proposal is accepted, individual research articles will be assessed through double-blind peer review. The guest editors of the successful issue should submit the full manuscript by 1 December 2023 following the journal's <u>Guide for Authors</u>, for a publication by December 2024.

Notification of acceptance: 31 March 2023

Deadline for submitting the final manuscript: 1st December 2023

Publication of the Special issue: December 2024
